

A distinctive 3-lobed, doubly saw-toothed leaf is usually less than 3 inches long. Note that the middle lobe is much larger than the side lobes. The leaves have a red stalk and the main vein is reddish as well.

The fruit is a cluster of samaras which have nearly parallel wings. The seed clusters often remain on the tree through the winter. The fragrant blossoms flower as the leaves unfurl in the spring.
